Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's Letter No. 4-9/2005-CD-II dated 20.12.2005 conveying therewith the detailed guidelines for supplementary nutrition under ICDS Scheme. It has now been decided by the Government of India to revise the financial norms for different categories of beneficiaries as under:-

Category	Existing Rates	Revised Rates
(i) Children (6 months to 72 months)	Rs.2.00 per child/per day	Rs. 4.00 per child/per day
(ii) Severely malnourished Children (6 months-72 months)	Rs.2.70 per child/per day	Rs. 6.00 per child/per day
(iii) Pregnant Women and Nursing mothers	Rs.2.30 per beneficiary per day.	Rs. 5.00 per beneficiary per day.

2. Presently Government of India is providing additional Central assistance for supplementary nutrition to all the States/UTs to the extent of 50% of the expenditure as per the financial norms laid down for various categories of beneficiaries or 50% of actual expenditure incurred by the States/UTs on supplementary nutrition, whichever is less.

Sir, Madam,

As per the existing pattern, Government of India provides 100% funds for components under ICDS(G) except SNP where 50% of the expenditure as per financial norms laid down for various categories of beneficiaries or 50% of actual expenditure incurred by the States/UTs on supplementary nutrition, whichever is less, is being provided.

It has now been decided by GOI to revise the sharing pattern of costs between Centre and States as under:-

States/UTs	ICDS(G)	SNP	Construction
NER	90:10	90:10	100%
Non NER	90:10	50:50	-

2. The other terms and conditions governing the honorary services of these functionaries will be as under :-

(a) The enhanced honorarium, would be exclusive of the additional honorarium to be paid by the States/UTs for work other than the ICDS/KSY/NPAG if entrusted to the AWWs/AWH.


(b) States/ UTs should pay AWWs/AWHs additional honorarium for any additional work that is entrusted to them. Such additional work should, however, be in the area of women and child development / welfare only and should not, in any manner, be in conflict with the duty hours of the Anganwadi centre. Work related to other Departments/Sectors should not be assigned in any circumstances. Additional honorarium should also be commensurate with the quantum of additional work assigned.

3. The Government of India, Ministry of Women and Child Development will provide necessary additional funds on account of upward revision of honoraria of Anganwadi Workers and Helpers in the Centrally-sponsored ICDS Scheme. Action may be taken immediately for release of arrears on account of enhanced honorarium to Anganwadi Workers/Helpers. This should be done with the funds available under ICDS (General) Scheme.

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
