In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution of India and in supersession of this Department Notification No. 4645-SW dated the 23rd March, 1981 on the subject the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating the recruitment to the post included in the West Bengal Junior Social Welfare Service under the Welfare Branch of the Relief and Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal :-

RULES

The method of and the qualifications required for recruitment to the posts included in the West Bengal Junior Social Welfare Service under the Welfare Branch of the Relief and Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal shall be as detailed below :

I. Appointing Authority - Governor of West Bengal.

II. Method of recruitment.

- (i) By selection (Direct recruitment) on the result of the West Bengal Civil Services (Executive) Examination. The Service should be included in Group-C of the said examination or
- (ii) by promotion on the basis of preliminary written test to be conducted by the public service commission, West Bengal for screening of candidates followed by interview of the successful candidates by the said commission from the following feeder post :
 - (a) Under the Directorate of Social Welfare all posts borne in the scale of Rs.440-1170/- and Rs.380-910/-.
 - (b) Under the Controller of Vagrancy West Bengal-all posts born in the scale of Rs.440-1170/- and Rs.380-910/-.

Provided that not more than 40% of the posts under the service (both permanent and temporary taken together) shall be filled up by promotion.

III. Qualifications and age of direct recruitment.

As prescribed for the West Bengal Civil Service (Executive) Examination.

IV. Eligibility for promotion :

5 years experience in a feeder post or posts taken together.

V. Special condition :

For service in the Homes for the Blind and / or Deaf and Dumb, a degree or diploma or certificate in the training of blind and or Deaf and Dumb shall be an essential qualification. Any person not in possession that he shall have to receive in-service-training for the Blind and/or Deaf and Dumb.

Note: Male candidates will be unsuitable for the post meant for institution for females and female candidates unsuitable for the post meant for the Institution for the Males.
