Sub: Revision of eligibility criteria for engagement to the position of AWWs and AWHs for all categories.

In partial modification of this Department's Memorandum No.4039-SW/3S-225/05, dated 20/12/2013 read with this Department's Memo No.3104-SW/3S-225/05(Pt.II) dated 19/09/2013 and also Memo. No.3487-SW/3S-48/14, dated 15/10/2014 i.e. with respect to the eligibility criteria of minimum educational qualification and age for engagement to the position of AWWs and AWHs for all categories (i.e. General, SC, ST, OBC etc.), the undersigned is directed, by order of the Governor, to say that the Governor, after careful consideration ,has been pleased to revise the said criteria ,in the public interest, to the following effect:

- (i) The minimum educational qualification for engagement to the position of AWWs and AWHs will be Class-XII(twelve) Pass.
- (ii) Age limit for engagement to the position of AWWs and AWHs will be 18-35 years.

All other contents in the aforesaid Memorandums shall remain unchanged.

This order will take immediate effect.
