MEMORANDUM

Sub: - Modification in Notification No.288-SW dated 25.01.2006 read with Memorandum No.2043-SW dated 18.07.2006 and Memorandum No.998-SW dated 07.03.2012 and Memorandum No.6003-SW/3S-225/05 dated 14.09.2012 relating to recruitment to the post of Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers under Govt. Quota.

With reference to the Deptt.'s Memorandum No.288-SW dated 25.01.2006 read with Memorandum No.2043-SW dated 18.07.2006 and Memorandum No.998-SW dated 07.03.2012 and Memorandum No.6003-SW/3S-225/05 dated 14.09.2012 relating to recruitment to the post of Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers under Govt. Quota, providing for mechanism to recruit AWWs and AWHs under Govt. quota in Govt. run and NGO-run ICDS Projects, the undersigned is directed, by order of the Governor to say that the Government after careful consideration has decided in the public interest to frame guidelines for recruitment to the post of Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers under Govt. Quota as under.

In the light of the above, Paras -A(1) (c) and A(1) (e) and A(2) (b) and A(2) (e) of the Memorandum No.288-SW dated 25.01.2006 read with Memorandum No.2043-SW dated 18.07.2006, No.998-SW dated 07.03.2012 and Memorandum No.6003-SW dated 24.09.2012 are modified here under in consonance with the structure of the District Selection and Monitoring Committee for selection of AWWs and AWHs.

GUIDELINE

As per existing order (No.288-SW/3S-225/05 dated 25th January, 2006), 5% of the total number of sanctioned posts in respect of Govt. run ICDS Projects will be selected by the Government from amongst the suitable inmates of Govt. and Govt. aided Welfare Homes or by others. The same will continue.

10% of the total number of sanctioned posts in respect of NGO run ICDS Projects will be selected by the Government from amongst the suitable inmates of Govt. and Govt. aided Welfare Homes or by others. The same will continue.

Qualification in respect of Anganwadi Workers -

Age - Women in the age group of 18 - 45 years.

Academic Qualification

Madhyamik / School
Final / High Madrasha
Or Equivalent
Examination passed
from a recognized Board
in case of general candidates.

Class - VIII Passed in case of SC / ST candidates.

This will apply in case of both Govt. and NGO-run ICDS Projects.

Qualification in respect of Anganwadi Helpers -

Age - Women in the age group of 18 - 45 years.

Academic Qualification - Class - IV passed. (For SC / ST candidates also)

This will apply in case of both Govt. and NGO-run ICDS Projects.

Other eligibility criteria of Anganwadi workers a well as Anganwadi Helpers may be included as follows:-

1) Suitable inmate of Govt. and Govt. aided Homes.

2) Women in distress, once all eligible candidates in (1) is exhausted and certified accordingly by the District Selection and Monitoring Committee.

Resident - A candidate should be a resident of the concerned Gram Panchayat/Ward.

Residential Certificate - Residential Certificate to be issued either by M.P / M.I.C. /M.O.S/
MLA/ DM/Collector/Addl. Collector / ADM/ SDO / BDO / Chairman
of Municipality / Councillor / Pradhan of Gram Panchayat /
Sabhadhipati, Panchayat Samiti.
In case of inmates from Govt. and Govt. aided Homes, residential
certificate may be issued by the Superintendent of the Home concerned.

Procedure of Selection -

Eligible candidates will apply to the - MIC of the Department of Child Development.

- A Selection Committee to be constituted as follows:-
- 1) M.I.C. of the Child Development Deptt. Chairperson.
- 2) Principal Secretary / Secretary of the Child Development Deptt. Member
- Two members, involved in Social Services, to be nominated by the MIC, Child Development Deptt.
 - The Selection Committee will select the candidates observing the guidelines.
