Memorandum

It is stipulated in Para 11 of Part "B" of the guideline issued by this department vide No.288-SW dated 25.01.2006 regarding recruitment of AWWs that a candidate must secure minimum 25 marks to qualify for viva-voce. Now it has been brought to the notice of this Department that in many cases a huge number of candidates have qualified in the written test and if all of them are called for viva-voce it will take a long time to complete the process and in that case it will not be possible for the members of Selection Committees, particularly the elected members, to remain present for a long period to take the test.

Now after careful consideration of the matter the Govt. in the Department of Women and Child Development and Social Welfare has decided to make the following modifications in the Department Memorandum No.288-SW dated 25.01.2006.

"If a huge number of candidates qualify in the written test for recruitment to the posts of AWW, the Selection Committee may call such candidates for viva-voce in the 1:5 ratio."
