Sub: Sanction of 17,512 Additional Anganwadi Centres  
in the existing ICDS Projects.

Sir,

Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India has conveyed sanction for setting up of 17,512 Additional Anganwadi Centres in the existing ICDS Projects vide letter No. 14-3/2006-CD.I dated 28.12.2006.

Now, the Governor has been pleased to accord sanction for setting up of 17,512 Additional Anganwadi Centres and creation of 700 posts of Supervisors @ 1 Supervisor for 25 Anganwadi Centres, 17,512 posts of Anganwadi Workers and 17,512 posts of Anganwadi Helpers w.e.f. the date of their actual joining up to 28.02.2008 for the present as detailed in the enclosed Statement - I.

The Governor has also been pleased to accord approval to the scales of recurring and non-recurring expenditures as detailed in the enclosed Statement-II.

The Governor has further been pleased to issue the following guidelines for setting up of the Additional Anganwadi Centres:-

- I. To give priority to set up the Additional Anganwadi Centres in the villages/localities predominantly inhabited by population belonging to ST/SC and Minority Community.
- II. Within the villages/localities to give priority, as far as feasible, to ST/SC and Minority community.
- III. To set up the Additional Anganwadi Centres in the ITDP Mouzas of the Projects as shown in the statement-I.
- IV. To give priority to set up Additional Anganwadi Centres in the closed Tea Gardens/other Tea Gardens/Forest Villages in the Projects of the districts of Darjeeling and Jalpaiguri.

As per directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court all the Additional Anganwadi Centres, sanction of which is now accorded, must be made operational by 30.09.2007.



Accordingly, after careful consideration of the matter, the Governor has been pleased to direct that candidates in the existing panels of Anganwadi Workers and the Anganwadi Helpers, if any, should be appointed after observing all necessary formalities for early operationalisation of the Anganwadi Centres. In the event of exhaustion of the existing panels all necessary steps should be taken forthwith for filling up of the remaining posts of Anganwadi Workers and the Anganwadi Helpers following the guidelines of this Deptt. Memorandum No. 288-SW dated 25.01.2006.

The expenditure will be debited to the head "2235-Social Security & Welfare-02-Social Welfare-102-Child Welfare-Centrally Sponsored (new Scheme)-003-Integrated Child Development Services Project Schemes".

The expenditure for Additional Honorarium for Anganwadi Workers and the Anganwadi Helpers will be debited to the head "2235-02-102-SP-020-31-01".

This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Deptt. vide their U.O.No. 719 Group-P (Service) dated 08.03.2007 and U.O. No. Group-E-36 dated 08.03.2007.
