Sub: **Distribution of THR among Out of School Adolescent Girls of 11 to 14 Years
under Scheme for Adolescent Girls for SAG Beneficiaries**

Sir/Madam,

In continuation of this Directorate No.1475 (23)/ICDM-Dte dated 14.9.21 it is further requested to arrange distribution of THR for the period of May-2021 and June-2021 at the scale of 2 (two) kg of Rice, 300 (three hundred) gm of Musur Dal and 2 (two) Kg of Potato to each beneficiary per month under SAG for all out of school girls within age group of 11 – 14 years.

Potato will be procured locally by the Anganwadi Workers. The rate of procurement for all districts except Darjeeling and Kalimpong may be between Rs. 11/- to 15/- per Kg. with Re. 1/- per Kg would be given as incidental and handling costs. The rate can be fixed by the District Magistrate from the aforesaid range in consultation with the Agri. Marketing Officer for the upcoming round of THR distribution. For Darjeeling and Kalimpong the rate of Potato would be Rs. 18/- per Kg. with Re. 1/- per Kg as incidental and handling costs.

The rates of Rice and Musur Dal would be as per latest order of the rate recommending committee issued by the Department.

The Anganwadi Workers will procure the Rice and Musur Dal at the aforesaid rates from the open market and bill for this procurement will be met out from SAG Nutrition component fund which will be allotted for this purpose shortly.

The dry THR distribution would be start from 1st October, 2021 and should be completed within a fortnight.

Precautionary measures in terms of social distancing, wearing mask, and sanitization should be taken care of while carrying forth the above THR distribution. Unnecessary gathering at the Anganwadi Centres should be avoided by doing house-to-house THR distribution by Anganwadi Workers and Helpers.
