The question of incorporating provisions in this department's Memorandum No.288-5W dated 25.01.06 read with Memorandum No.3487-SW dated 15.10.2014 with respect to the Income Ceiling of the father/husband/legal guardian of the eligible daughter of the deceased Anganwadi Workers/Anganwadi Helpers only in Died-in-Harness cases has been under active consideration of this Department for quite some time back. It is imperative to include income ceiling in the provision of the current guidelines while considering employments in Died-in-Harness cases for the daughter of the deceased AWWs/AWHs of ICDS Scheme following guidelines aforementioned.

Now, in continuation of this Department Memorandum No.288-SW dated 25.01.06 and Memorandum No.3487-SW dated 15.10.14, the undersigned is directed to say that the gross annual income of the father/husband/legal guardian of the applicant under "Died-in-Harness" cases should not exceed Rs.1,20,000/- (Rupees one lakh twenty thousand) only for considering engagements to the posts of AWWs/AWHs under Died-in-Harness Cases.

The Income Certificates to this effect should be produced from employers in respect of employed persons and for self-employed persons such certificates stating definite income from all sources should be obtained either from Pradhan/Councilors/MLAs/MPs/Chairpersons/Mayors /Sabhapatis / Sabhadhipati/ or from any Executive Officers including BDOs. Executive Officers of Municipalities/Secretary or Commissioner of Municipal Corporations.

The new guidelines will come into effect w.e.f. date of issue of this order.
