

Observation on MPR of February, 2021:

Maximum non operational (%) is in Paschim Bardhaman(8%) which is 4 times higher than state average % for the month, followed by Purba Medinipore and Kochbehar (5% each) and South 24 pgs(4%).

Bankura, Darjeeling, Jalpaiguri, Nadia, Purulia, Uttar Dinajpur have reported shortfall in providing of SNP in 100% AWCs.

Beneficiary coverage for children 6m-6 yrs shows over achievement in 4 districts (with respect to estimated 6m-6 yrs child population)- 104% in Jhargram, 102% in Paschim Medinipore, Alipurduar and Kochbehar.

On the other hand, under achievement was reportedly found in 8 districts. of which, maximum under achievement (with respect to state average) in 3 districts are - 85% in Paschim bardhaman, and 87% in Kolkata and 90% in Hooghly. As this is based on estimated child population 6m-6yrs, exact coverage may be little different.

Beneficiary coverage for P&L women shows over achievement in Jalpaiguri-103%. Less than state average % for the month was reported in 7 districts, of them maximum was in Paschim Bardhaman and Kolkata (90% each), followed by North 24 Parganas and Uttar Dinajpur (94% each), Kalimpong, Malda and Paschim medinipore (97% each).

Observation on MPR of March,2021:

Maximum non operational (%) is in Paschim Bardhaman(8%) which is 4 times higher than state average % for the month, followed by Purba Medinipore (5%) and South 24 pgs and Coochbehar(each with 4%)

Beneficiary coverage for children 6m-6 yrs shows over achievement in 4 districts (with respect to estimated 6m-6 yrs child population)- 105% in Alipurduar, 103% in Jhargram 102% in Paschim Medinipore, and 101% in Jalpaiguri. On the other hand, under achievement (with respect to state average) was reported in 6 districts, of them lowest 3 districts are - 80% in North 24 parganas, 85% in Paschim bardhaman, and 88% in Kolkata. As this is based on estimated child population 6m-6yrs, exact coverage may be little different.

Beneficiary coverage for P&L women shows over achievement in 3 districts- 107% in Nadia, 101% in Jalpaiguri and Bankura. Less than state average % for the month was reported in 5 districts, of them maximum lowest coverage are reported by North 24 Parganas (81%), followed by kolkata (89%) and Kalimpong (90%).

Directorate may be requested to look into the under coverage of reported AWCs and over coverage of beneficiaries.
