MEMORANDUM

In this Deptt. Memorandum No. 3367-SW dated 07.11.2006 Sub-Divisional Officers were allowed to distribute answer scripts of the Anganwadi Workers to the WBCS(Exe.) Officers posted in Sub-Divisional Headquarters/District headquarter for scrutiny in consultation with the District Magistrates except in the Projects located in Kolkata.

It has been brought to the notice of the Govt. in the Deptt. of Women &

Child Development and Social Welfare that a huge number of candidates have appeared at the written examinations for the post of Anganwadi Workers. Accordingly it has become unmanageable on the part of the Sub-Divisional Officers and the WBCS (Exe.) Officers only to examine the answer scripts

Now, after careful consideration of the matter the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased in partial modification of this Deptt. Memorandum No. 3367-SW dated 07.11.2006 to allow the Sub-Divisional Officers to distribute the answer scripts for the post of Anganwadi Workers for scrutiny to the Group 'A' officers as will be selected by him/her. The other terms and conditions contained in this Deptt. Memorandum No. 3367-SW dated 07.11.2006 will remain unchanged.

Similarly, in case of the ICDS Projects in Kolkata the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor in partial modification of this Deptt. Memorandum No. 288-SW dated 25.01.2006 has been pleased to allow the Additional Director of Social Welfare, West Bengal to distribute the answer scripts for the post of Anganwadi Workers for scrutiny to the Group 'A' Officers as will be selected by him for scrutiny.

However, the responsibility of preserving the answer scripts and also the sheets containing marks obtained by the candidates in the written examination will remain entrusted to the Additional Director of Social Welfare, West Bengal/Sub-Divisional Officers as the case may be.
