Sub: Sanction of 53 new ICDS Projects with 4622 AWCs, 5 new ICDS Project Offices and the posts under the ICDS Scheme in this State.

Sir,

Govt. of India has conveyed sanction for setting up of 53 new ICDS Projects with 5123 AWCs and 5 new ICDS Project Offices. Thereafter sanction was accorded by the State Govt. in the Deptt. of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare vide G.O. No.374(2)-SW/FS dated 5.12.2005 for setting up of 53 new ICDS Projects, 5 new ICDS Project Offices, creation of temporary posts/staff and sanction of non-recurring and recurring expenditure. After issuance of the G.O. certain typographical/other mistakes were detected therein. Accordingly the G.O. No.374(2)-SW/FS dated 5.12.2005 was cancelled vide this Dept. Memorandum No.4882-SW/3S-225/05 dated 13.12.2005.

2. Now, after careful consideration of the matter the Governor has been pleased to accord sanction for setting up of 53 new ICDS Projects with 4622 AWCs, 5 new ICDS Project Offices under the ICDS Scheme as detailed in the enclosed Statements - I and IA.

3. After further careful consideration of the matter the Governor has been pleased to reallocate 501 AWCs (5123 - 4622) to the existing ICDS Projects to cover the uncovered beneficiaries including the uncovered beneficiaries in the Tea Gardens and Forest Villages after rational distribution of 4622 AWCs among the 51 new ICDS Projects in the Municipal Corporations and Municipalities and 2 new Rural ICDS Projects at Kaliachak-I and Kharagpur-II.

4. The Governor has also been pleased to accord sanction to the creation of the temporary posts for the aforesaid new ICDS Projects and Project Offices as detailed in the enclosed Statement - II with immediate effect and the posts are retained till 28.2.2006.

5. The Governor has further been pleased to accord approval to the scales of Recurring and Non-recurring expenditure in the ICDS Projects as detailed in the enclosed Statement - III.

6. Some AWCs are already functioning in the newly sanctioned ICDS Projects in the municipal areas out of the AWCs in the existing Rural/Tribal/Urban ICDS Projects. Accordingly the Governor has been pleased to allocate AWCs in the newly sanctioned ICDS Projects in the municipalities taking into consideration the number of AWCs already functioning there. The Governor has also been pleased to transfer the AWCs already functioning in the municipalities to these newly sanctioned ICDS Projects along with the posts of Supervisors commensurate with the number of such AWCs.

The transfer of Supervisors, AWMs and the AWHs from the existing ICDS Projects will come into effect after posting of CDPOs in the newly created ICDS Projects.

7. The Governor has further been pleased to transfer AWCs and required number of posts of Supervisors as per schematic pattern to the newly created 5 ICDS Project Offices - Burdwan-II (R), Pandabeswar(R), Harirampur(R), Matigara (T) and Kharibari (T) from the existing ICDS Projects as detailed at Statement - IA. The Governor has been pleased to rename the existing 5 ICDS Projects as detailed at Statement - IA.

The Governor has also been pleased to issue the following guidelines for setting up of AWCs in the newly sanctioned ICDS Projects:-

- I. To give priority to set up new AWCs in the villages / localities predominantly inhabited by population belonging to SC/ST and minority community.
- II. Within the villages / localities to give priority, as far as feasible, to set up AWCs in the areas inhabited by population belonging to SC/ST and minority community.
8. Charges involved may be debited to the head, (i) "2235-Social Security & Welfare-02-Social Welfare-102-Child Welfare-Centrally Sponsored (New Scheme)-003-Integrated Child Development Services Project Scheme" and in case of Anganwadi Worker and Helper the additional honorarium will also be met from (ii) "2235-02-102-SP-020-31-01" in the State Budget.

This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Deptt. vide their U/O No.3976 - Group-P (Service) dated 26.10.2005 and U/O No. Group-E - 5 dated 06.01.2006.

Now, after careful consideration of the matter the Governor has been pleased to accord sanction for setting up of 11977 additional AWCs and creation of temporary additional posts of Supervisors, AWWs and AWHs for existing ICDS Projects in this State w.e.f. the actual date of joining upto 28.02.2006 for the present as detailed in the enclosed Statement-I.

3. Now, after further careful consideration of the matter the Governor has also been pleased to reallocate 501 AWCs to existing ICDS Projects available from the newly sanctioned 51 Urban ICDS Projects to cover more uncovered beneficiaries including the uncovered beneficiaries in the Tea Gardens and Forest Villages.

4. The Governor has also been pleased to accord approval to the scales of recurring and non-recurring expenditure as detailed in the enclosed Statement-II.

5. Some AWCs are already functioning in the Municipal areas out of the AWCs in the existing Rural/Tribal/Urban ICDS Projects. Some of the AWCs are also functioning in the newly created Urban ICDS Projects. Accordingly the Governor has been pleased to transfer the AWCs already functioning in the Municipalities and in the newly created Urban ICDS Projects, along with the posts of Supervisors, commensurate with the number of such AWCs transferred. The Supervisors, AWWs and AWHs with the transfer of such AWCs will be working in the newly created ICDS Projects. In the similar way the position of the number of Supervisors, AWWs and the AWHs has been indicated at Statement-I due to bifurcation of 5 ICDS Projects viz. Burdwan, Andal, Banshihari, Siliguri-Naxalbari and Kharibari-Phansidewa.

The transfer of Supervisors, AWWs and the AWHs from the existing ICDS Projects to the newly created ICDS Projects will come into effect after posting of CDPOs.

6. The Governor has also been pleased to sanction additional AWCs to cover the uncovered beneficiaries in the Municipal areas as detailed in Statement-I. These AWCs will remain attached to the existing Rural/Tribal ICDS Projects.

7. The Governor has further been pleased to issue the following guidelines for setting up of additional AWCs:-

- i) To give priority to set up new AWCs in the villages/localities predominantly inhabited by population belonging to SC/ST and minority community.
- ii) Within the villages/localities to give priority, as far as feasible to SC/ST and minority community.
- iii) To give priority to set up AWCs in the Forest Villages.
- iv) To give priority to set up AWCs in the Tea Gardens in the districts of Darjeeling and Jalpaiguri.

8. The expenditure will be debited to the head (1) "2235-Social Security & Welfare-02-Social Welfare-102-Child Welfare-Centrally Sponsored (New Scheme)-003-Integrated Child Development Services Project Scheme" and (2) "2235-02-102-SP-020-31-01" (in case of additional honorarium of AWWs and AWHs) in the State Budget until further orders.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Deptt. vide their U/O No. 3976 - Group-P (Service) dated 26.10.2005 and U/O No. Group-E-5 dated 06.01.2006.

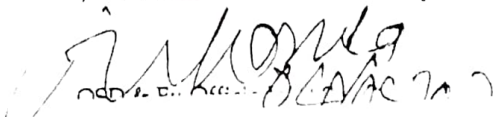

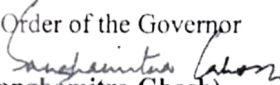

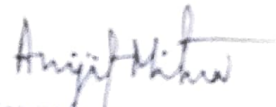
